Perry highlighted the new requirement for the MCPs to list if the MOU had redlined edits that would necessitate a review and approval from DHCS. Perry covered the criteria in which DHCS provided on what would constitute a need for a DHCS review versus what changes would not need to be submitted for review. Anthem Blue Cross: Jared provided CalAIM resources to the group with the updated Anthem ECM flyers that are provider facing. 	Liz reported out: Tulare County BH is actively working on their Justice Involved readiness assessment. TCBH is interested in forming a work group between the MCPs and the other necessary stakeholders to discuss JI workflow for linkage. Tulare County local setting for juvenile justice facilities, and county jails will not be going live with pre-release services until 2026. The BH department are planning to be ready to receive individuals that may be eligible for pre-release services in October 2024, for individuals returning from being incarcerated in other counties. Liz also highlighted the need to explore the options, the gaps and the flexibility of the transportation benefit given the frequent and urgent nature of scheduled appointments for members.
