CRP WIC indicated that they have reached out to the MCPs liaisons regarding their Annual Breast-Feeding Celebration on May 2, 2025. This is the 25 annual anniversary for the celebration in which they invite their pregnant and post-partum WIC participants, but it is also open to the public. The event is aimed to share information and resource for breast feeding support, for those thinking about breast feeding, and celebrate the WIC families that are breast feeding. The lactation consultants and peer counselors have worked with their clients that may have struggled with breast feeding for different reasons and the celebration provides the opportunity to celebrate the strides of the families. The Celebration will be held at McClatchy Pary in Sacramento. Staffing Changes - WIC has hired "a whole lot of new staff" in the past couple of months, specifically their core WIC service staff, WIC nutritionists and clerks.	
Stephanie and Maureen have had the opportunity to join some virtual legislation for Doris Matsui office and Ami Berri office to help with encouraging their support on legislation that will directly impact WIC.	
California Department of Public Health WIC received a bonus from USDA last year for breast feeding support in California and with that CASH bonus has opened a scholarship program to become a lactation consultant and 4 of the WIC staff applied and all were granted the scholarship and will be starting that program in April 2025 and once completed they are able to begin collecting their clinical hours and then sit for the IBCLC exam.	
Maureen shared that they are a dietetic internship preceptor site for UCD Medical Center, Sacramento State, and University of Pacific Dietetic Internship on the nutrition side of the program. To become a Dietician, you have to do an internship and take an exam, and they have partnered with the schools to do the WIC and Community Nutrition rotation.	
Emely from Kaiser shared for the upcoming Annual Breast-Feeding Celebration she has sent off the information to their Community Health Program to determine on how they are able to support. She shared with the CRP WIC staff that if they have not heard anything back in the next week to outreach to her so that she is able to follow- up with her team. It was asked during this time if CRP WIC would be able to include the MCPs onto their flyers as supporters. CRP WIC indicated that for any donors that they are included on their marketing materials. Anthem currently is one of the sponsors and is currently listed on the current flyer they are sharing. They are currently working on a postcard to send to those who are eligible to participate in WIC. Molina also indicated that they would forward the information to their team. Health Net also shared that they have an upcoming meeting to discuss the possibility of participating in the Celebration and that they would be following up once it was determined.	
Maureen shared that they are a CS subcontracted with Vivant with the Asthma Remediation Grant, they have just started to "kickoff" that outreach. Vivant will be streamlining the asthma patient and directed to CRP WIC where home assessment will be conducted and the asthma remediation services.
