III.	<p>Health Plan Updates:</p> <p>Anthem:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Desiree shared a reminder about redetermination and encouraging the Medi-Cal members to update their information to avoid lapse in coverage. • It was also discussed regarding the operationalization of the MOU, and how the implementation of the MOU will take some work as there are some additional requirements in the MOU and will have to communicate and meet more frequently to see what those processes look like as we work to implementing the MOU. • Desiree shared that there will be additional MOUs but as of date DHCS has shared them being available 1/1/2025 those MOUs to include First5, COCs, area on aging, and others that DHCS has listed on their website. Desiree asked Inyo County to share any contacts from those agencies, if possible, to start conversation as the health plans prepare for those upcoming MOUs. Inyo County shared that those agencies are already represented in our quarterly meetings. Desiree shared that the health plans would be reaching out to begin those MOU conversations. • Anthem shared that they are looking to finalize their behavioral health data sharing and are looing to receive Inyo County's Tax ID number if possible, so internally they can name the county's profile. • Desiree connected with Stephanie regarding the SMART Goal as she indicated that she sent in some data from Anthem in April. Stephane shared that she had been out in April and just recently returned to the office and will review once she has the opportunity and to connect with Anthem and Health Net. It was discussed that on August 1, 2024, that a deliverable that DHCS is due that is an attestation that we are working collaboratively with the County on their CHA/CHIP process and working on the SMART Goal. <p>Health Net:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Annesha did not have any additional relevant updates.
