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I.	Introductions <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Rosy welcomed everyone to the meeting and attendees introduced themselves by name and role. 	All
II.	Regional Center Updates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> CVRC has a volume of intakes for eligibility determinations, with over 2000 individuals in the intake process which is double any other Regional Center in the entire State. In order to maintain their caseload ratio, last month CVRC hired 21 service coordinators, and they had a new growth team in their Visalia office, and they are looking to hire another 20 to 25. CVRC is waiting for the budget to be signed, and they do anticipate getting a little bit more funding for at least their growth positions. CVRC shared that they are at a budget deficit this year, so they are just kind of holding but they are hopeful that they will be able to do another hiring cycle probably in the month of September. CVRC hired another psychologist and she's been in training. Her name is Dr. Romero. They have a total of three psychologist and one psych associate that are completing eligibility and apparent reviews, meetings with service coordinators dealing with appeals and anything else that falls into their category. CVRC shared that most of their growth, probably 80% plus has been in the category of autism cases. They are still seeing a growth in their intellectual disability category, but it's much lower than it has been in the past and they are actually seeing a decline in cerebral palsy and epilepsy areas for this past fiscal year. CVRC stated that autism is number 1 diagnosis, with 90% of cases assigned to service coordinators. Self-referrals may start happening. Early Start group for the zero through 36 months still grows steady, with more children found eligible under autism category. Pediatricians are great referral sources. 	CVRC Team
