For our first Quarterly Care Coordination meeting, in which we had the privilege to welcome representatives from all four health plans, we focused this session primarily on the MOU development.
In our discussion with Celia, we explored how to efficiently execute the MOU, considering the representation from the four health plans, each serving different counties within the Kern Regional Center's jurisdiction. Here is a summary of the regions each health plan operates within:
Anthem: Inyo, Kern, and Mono Counties Health Net: Inyo and Mono Counties Kaiser: Kern County Kern Health Plan: Kern County
After in-depth deliberation, the collective consensus was to implement the MOUs at a county level. This called for a separate meeting among the health plans to further unravel this strategy and identify the most efficient approach. <i>In light of reducing the burden on KRC, the health plans have come to the agreement of executing a consolidated MOU.</i> The intention behind this strategy is to streamline KRC's load by decreasing the number of separate MOUs from three to one in attempt to respect staff capacity and bandwidth. This single MOU will encompass all four health plans with the document designating which health plan is operative in each county.
Kern Family Health intends to take the lead on MOU execution moving forward, with the ongoing support from the other health plans.
Once the health plans have completed all necessary redlining, this updated draft version of the Kern Regional Center MOU will be forwarded to KRC for their review. Please disregard the previously shared MOU that included edits from Anthem and Health Net. Our revised approach intends to extend the incorporation to both Kaiser and Kern Family Health as well.
