 1) State is shifting responsibility of cost burden of late penalties to Counties Annual IHSS redetermination 90% compliance from the State The state is losing 6% of federal matching funds for noncompliance with annual assessments and the county will be estimated cost of 250K per month as a result of that shift to the counties for the penalties (at 50% cost share with state). Challenges with demand and increased penalties to the County Will cause delay in cases and response rate 2) Are there conversations with the State to limit family providers (Engrid, KP) Complications when obligating clients to use certain providers i. The State has a different system which the County hasn't considered since it increases costs for both the County and the client Kern IHSS has a self-determination model 3) Average turnaround after application submitted 	Kern IHSS
