

**Commonwealth Coordinated Care Plus, or CCC Plus, is Virginia's health care program for people who have Medicaid and need extra help managing their care.**

**Who gets it?**

You might be eligible if you:

- Have Medicare, too
- Get long-term services and supports
- Live in a nursing facility
- Are aged, blind or disabled (ABD)
- Have a developmental disability – You'll get CCC Plus for your acute and primary care.

If you're eligible, the state will send you a letter telling you which plan you're in.

All Commonwealth Coordinated Care and ABD members start CCC Plus January 1, 2018.
